

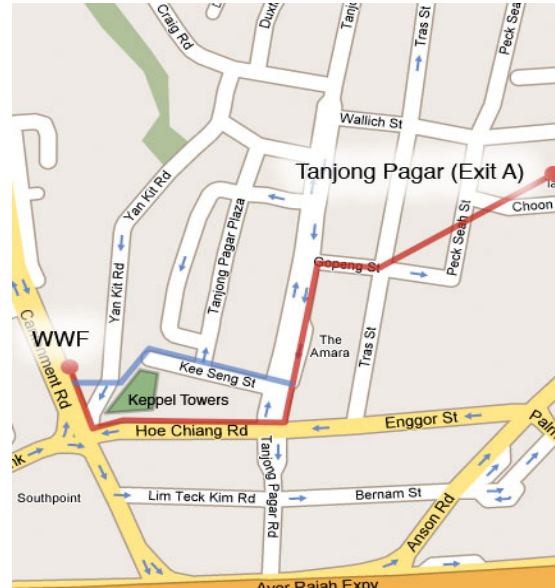
## Directions To WWF Singapore

If you are travelling by Train, we suggest you take this route :

From **Tanjong Pagar MRT (EW 15)**

- Exit by **Tanjong Pagar MRT Station Exit A**.
- Walk towards *The Amara Singapore* (Hotel), along **Gopeng Street**.
- Walk down **Tanjong Pagar Road**, until a T Junction with **Hoe Chiang Road**. Turn right and walk along Hoe Chiang Road.
- At the T Junction of **Hoe Chiang Road** and **Cantonment Road**, with *Keppel Towers* on the right, turn right towards **Cantonment Road**.

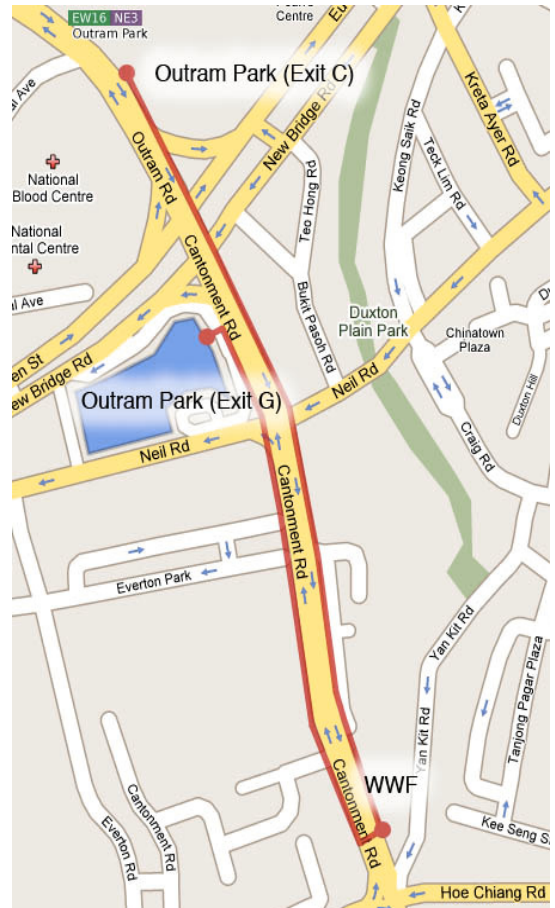


Alternatively you can alight from **Outram Park MRT (NE 3)** :

- Exit at **Outram Park (NEL) MRT Station Exit A**, to be at Street Level which is opposite the Singapore General Hospital. Board SMRT Bus # 75 – Yellow Bus – from the Bus Stop in front which is also near a Taxi Stand. Please alight at the next Bus Stop. Walk a short distance in line with the traffic direction and you would see WWF Singapore on the left side. It is sandwiched between a previous Buddhist Art Museum and a Chinese Temple.

Or :

- Exit at **Outram Park (NEL) MRT Station Exit G**, at the *Police Cantonment Complex*. Turn right and walk down along **Cantonment Road**.
- After crossing the junction at **Neil Road**, *The Pinnacle@Duxton* (under construction) will be on the left and *Residential Apartments* will be on the right. Continue walking.
- Cross the Overhead Bridge after the *Maritime House* on your right. WWF Singapore is a short walk from the Bus Stop.



## If you are driving :

You can park at Block 10, Cantonment Close at the Multi Storey Car Park. Take the Overhead Bridge to reach 237 Cantonment Road. You will see the sign 'WWF – World Wide Fund For Nature (Singapore) Limited'.
